Evohé began in 2005 against all odds by establishing production outside the respected DO's of Aragon. The project started with an attempt to make a great Garnacha from Aragon in the desert lands where the grape originated. Our goal was also to make it in such way that it would be affordable to everyone. Barrel aging was instantly eliminated. We felt that a great wine could be produced with pure fruit from a varietal that had been cultivated for over 800 years....old vines with old clones....vineyards with genetic diversity. The chosen land was in the area of Bajo Aragon, the birthplace Garnacha where we found vines with exceptional conditions for growth.

Our conclusion was *"What the hell... Why should we do what everybody else does? Here we have the best possible vines to make an epic wine"*.

It was not easy and many did not believe in our project. The wine was great, but who would want a wine from an area without a DO? Today Evohé is asynonym for Great Old Vine Garnacha.

Evohe Garnacha's success set our eyes on other native grapes from these areas. Our Tempranillo is the first result. From the north-western cool, green sub-mountain areas Tempranillo grows into a smooth and velvety wine. Its seeds turn brown and ripe. The grape has been planted here since the 13th Century, so it can be considered a local grape.

More wines are on the way. Mazuela also known as Cariñena, Crujillón, Samsó... As the saying goes: *"A loved child has many names."* This grape has also had a long tradition in this area. Many say it came from the area around Cariñena just south of Zaragoza. We have chosen vines from Valdejalón south-west of our home town.

There is much to do. It is essential for us to keep faith in Evohé and our values to make wines from traditional local grapes. Good wine made with love and dedication will triumph.

Well, at least, we think.... you can always compare and make up your mind.
